Paktika (Sharan City)

Literacy Civil Society requests the government not to treat provinces based on double standards and provide the electricity imported from Tajikistan and Turkmenistan to Paktika province.

The agreement of importing electricity from Turkmenistan and Tajikistan to Afghanistan was signed few years back. Many provinces have so far provided with the facility while work on extension of the service to other provinces of the country is underway.

Literacy Civil Society members also request for extension of imported electricity to Paktika as well so residents of the province feel the Afghan government works for them and their rights are not violated.

If Paktika province is not provided with electricity it would prove double standard treatment, something that forces us to stage civil movements to protest it.

No any imported electricity has so far provided to Paktika province where people currently use power generators and solar system to light their homes.
